Toddler Program

Montclare Curious Crocs runs from Tuesday, October 13th through Thursday, December 17th. These classes are much shorter than our typical day at Montclare, and do not involve having children separate from their grown up, however, these classes help prepare children for what preschool is all about.

Toddlers from 12 months to 24 months are just beginning to test out their independence. A certain amount of back and forth from “home base” (a trusted caregiver) is not only expected, but typical of this age. Toddlers eagerly toddle away, and then toddle back to their caregivers. They may need to “check-in” and make sure that their special grown up is still available to them when they need them. In **Curious Crocs**, we gently encourage toddlers’ budding independence by providing a safe space for exploration and discovery with our experienced teaching staff.
